


Comparison 2006 vs. 2019:




IIOA Membership as of 20 June 2019: 676 Persons, 60 Countries

Financial Report

IIOA Financials 2018



- For 2018, IIOA shows a marked **surplus** of US\$ 21,700.
- Significant change in 2018: all payments for **ESR editorial work** is now routed through IIOA books. Reason: Records revealed that for 2013-17 not all agreed payments to our editors had been made by our publisher!
 - Result: both income and expenditure of IIOA will systematically increase by € 20,000 p.a.
 - Taylor & Francis made a compensation payment of US\$20,000 for arrears
 - Arrears have been wired to IIOA by the publisher and paid out to editors, but invoiced only in 2019 by two editors, which shows up as €18,000.- cash surplus.
- **Surplus** of over US\$ 4,800 from **Juiz de Fora Conference**.
- **Royalties slightly lower** at US\$ 35,800.-
- **Institutional Membership** slightly up to over US\$13,400.
- **Private Membership** contributions steady at US\$15,200.
- **Council Travel** expenditures lower than expected at US\$ 9,600.-
- **ISIOA** expenditures low at US\$1,000.
- **IT Expenditures** with US\$ 10,000.- at expected levels. They include restructuring of the conference website template, integration of IIOA members area and website on council function, and COPASS improvements.
- **Travel Grants remained high** at US\$27,000.
- **Prizes and Awards** high at US\$ 3,500 (including the REAL Prize for Flash Sessions: US\$300, 1:1 matched by IIOA).




Figure 1: Box plot of the distribution of Impact Factors for economics journals in 2017 (*ESR in 2017=2.429*)





State of Play with the UN Handbook

- Need to update present version *Handbook on Input-Output Compilation and Analysis* (1999).
- Reflect the new SNA, BPM, SEEA, ISIC, CPC, etc.
- UNSD formally started revision process in January 2013.
- Editorial Board/Expert Group in place (April 2013) led by UNSD
 - 12 Members plus UNSD – Editor Sanjiv Mahajan (ONS, UK)
- 21 Chapters drafted plus supplementary sections like references etc.
- UNSD formatting into UN house style (some restructuring): > 670 pages
- Global Consultation in summer 2017 and **publication by end 2017**
- Title: *UN Handbook on Supply, Use and Input Output Tables with extensions and applications.*




