

Travel grants for the International IO Conference in São Paulo

The International Input-Output Association (IIOA) is pleased to announce that also for the forthcoming International IO Conference in Sao Paulo travel grants will be provided, as was the case for the last five conferences.

The IIOA will provide up to five grants to young experts resident in non-OCED member countries of up to US \$ 2.000.- each. The Travel Grant Committee of the IIOA will award the grants to a selected set of qualified applicants who fulfill the following criteria:

- Being a IIOA member
- Born after 1968
- Resident in a non-OECD country
- Accepted unpublished conference paper, and
- Not having received an IIOA travel grant for either the International Input-Output Conference in Istanbul (2007) or the IO Conference in Seville (2008).

Authors who wish to apply for a travel grant should submit their **full paper** to the Chair of the Scientific Program Committee by **12th March, 2009**.
