

## **Review of European methodologies for SUIOT compilation in ESA2010**

Topic: Eurostat: Updating Supply and Use Tables, further extensions

Following the revision of international standards for macro-economic accounting and classifications (SNA 2008, BPM6) and their implementation at European level, Eurostat took the opportunity of the change of system accounts methodology to address European countries with a questionnaire on the compilation of Supply, Use and Input-output tables at national level. The questionnaires were transmitted to the European Statistical Office in 2014. The paper summarises the European answers going through the following chapters: organisation, data sources, compilation process, methodological aspects, dissemination and quality. From the analysis critical and fundamental issues will be addressed in the paper such as the statistical unit underlying SUIOT compilation, the role of SUT in the GDP compilation and the compilation of IOT.
