Significant statistical developments and changes for IIOA Members attention

Overview of statistical changes





Over next few years, there are several changes to the statistical landscape:

- Macroeconomic statistical standards
 - 2025 System of National Accounts (2025 SNA) to be endorsed by UNSC in March 2025.
 - New European System of Accounts (likely to be ESA 2027).
 - Balance of Payments and Institutional Investment Position Manual (BPM7) to be endorsed by BOPCOM in March 2025.
 - IMF Government Finance Statistics (GFS).
 - System of Environmental-Economic Accounting (SEEA).

Statistical frameworks

- International Standard Industrial Classification (ISIC) in 2023 and the NACE.
- Central Product Classification (CPC) in 2024 and Classification of Products by Activity (CPA).
- Classification of Individual Consumption by Purpose (COICOP).
- Classification of Functions of Government (COFOG).







Institutional Members 2024





IIOA Membership 2010 and 2024


Members by Country Group and Activity





IIOA Membership as of 28 June 2024: 888 Persons, 65 Countries






"Hewings Ratio"


IIOA Financials 2023



- According to Cash Accounting IIOA year-end results show a surplus of US\$ 4,400.
- ... even though we had the highest Volume of Travel Grants for Young IIOA Researchers in IIOA history (US\$ 35.800).
- ... however, some higher expenses have been **delayed to 2024** (z.B. Audit costs 2022, Editorial Expenses, Sir Richard Stone Prize 2023, in total **US\$ 12,500**).
- Royalties for the ESR Journal is lower than at all-time-high (= 2021, paid in 2022), but still high (US\$ 42,000), they increased again by 13% as reported by T&F in January 2024. Editorial Works sponsoring stays constant (US\$ 20,000).
- Membership contributions of private members increased to over US\$ 17,000.
- **Institutional Membership contributions,** after a year of very high payments, fell to **US\$ 11,000.** Another rise is expected in 2024, with one institution already having paid arrears of past years.
- Interest gains rose to over US\$ 5,000.- as the FED offered good interest on US\$-holdings.
- A small **Non-Members Surcharge** of the Alghero conference added **€2.500.**-
- The **IIOA Archive Project** created costs of over \$9,600.-, which includes lawyers, document logistics, a salary for our Indian support Anu for data entry and validation.
- The ISIOA School has become popular. Trainers for the educational modules at the conference 2023 cost about \$2,700
- We locked-in a 3 year multi-year low fee for the **Conference-App WHOVA**, amounting to \$4,200, saving us US\$ 2,000 for the years 2023, 2024, 2025.
- Office expenditure rose in 2023 (\$2,000), as Oliver Fritz needed a performant, stabile running, low weight laptop. (WIFO does not offer good equipment for IIOA purposes, and has a strict device standard with big and heavy computers.) High work productivity of Oliver Fritz is critical for overall IIOA operations, so IIOA provides his equipment.
- IT service expenditures continued at ca. the previous year level \$11,300 and included conference systems enhancements and website creation, webinars, archives database development.
- All other expenditures were constant or lower than in years before, and are well in check. IIOA productivity remains superbly high for an 800+ members global organization.

2023 Quick Summary



- 1. 2023 was a good year for IIOA, with a **popular conference** in Italy, **140 new members**, **lots of activities** and development **as well as very generous travel grants** for young researchers.
- **2. After the pandemic** years of 2020-2021, it was appropriate to fuel the global IO community with a set of good initiatives and a revival of conferences in Europe in an attractive location.
- 3. With a total of over \$360,000 Euro in assets, IIOA has grown to a financially resilient Organization for the way it is currently operated. IIOA is hard to beat in terms of organizational efficiency. We can be optimistic for the years to come.
- 4. With the **United Nations Organization** having applied to host our **global IIOA conference** at their premises in Chile (UNECLAC) in 2024, IIOA has reached a new level of operational realm, and we hope awareness of its contribution.

Outlook for 2024



- Royalties jump by 13% to over US\$ 47,500.
- Editorial Works funding by T&F increase by 2% as agreed US\$ 20,400.
- Interest income expected constant at US\$ 5,000.
- We conservatively estimate a US\$ 2,000 Non-Members Surcharge Contribution from the Santiago Conference.
- Private and Institutional Membership contributions estimated at average of past years US\$ 30,000.
- Travel grants for young scholars remain the highest expenditure item, as well as cooperation with YSI Programme: joint grants will continue!
- Administration Costs: expected constant.
- IT Costs: expected at 6-year average of US\$10,500.
- IO Archive project will continue: provision of US\$ 7,000 for data entry and validation, legal support, shipment of rare physical archive originals.
- ISIOA Trainings expected at previous level: US\$ 2,500
- Based on conservative estimates we expect a small surplus of US\$ 700.










Article Downloads - Usage by Country & Region








Origin of Submissions





Geography of Submissions





Average Speed of Article Publication*









Introduction

The IIOA introduced a series of webinars as one of the responses to the COVID-19 pandemic and the cancellation of the 2020 and 2021 annual IIOA Conferences. The aims of these webinars include:

- · sharing information, research, developments and analyses;
- · promotion of innovative ideas and inspiring others;
- providing another IIOA channel for learning and development for younger scholars; and
- · least of all, seeing / hearing albeit online, existing friends and colleagues as well as newbies.

Topics can be of any nature relating to Input-Output and the presenters from within the IIOA community or beyond.

Background


